Background:

Cal-Am proposed a meter based surcharge for the recovery of the WRAM/MCBA balance in A.15-07-019. All parties to that proceeding had the opportunity to provide input into the outcome of the recovery. Ultimately after the proceeding and an audit, the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) issued Decision (“D.”) 16-12-003, which states that Cal-Am is authorized a meter based surcharge over five years at the 90-day commercial paper rate. This advice letter requests the authority to implement the new surcharge after adjustments for collections from existing surcharges.

Purpose:

As is noted above, the purpose of this Advice Letter is to comply with California Public Utility Commission D.16-12-003 Ordering Paragraph #1:

“California-American Water Company (Cal-Am) shall, within 30 days of the date of this decision, file a Tier 2 advice letter in conformance with General Order 96-B. The advice letter shall request recovery of the Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism/Modified Cost Balancing Account (WRAM/MCBA) balance through 2014 for the Monterey District of \$39.8 million authorized in this decision, reduced by collections from existing WRAM/MCBA surcharges, to be recovered over five years with interest at the 90-day commercial paper rate. The advice letter shall clearly and fully itemize the WRAM/MCBA balance through 2014, including adjustments for collections from existing surcharges. The recovery shall be by a fixed monthly surcharge assessed on the basis of meter size using standard meter ratios. The multiple volumetric surcharges now in place for this recovery shall be terminated concurrent with the advice letter becoming effective. When the rates are to become effective, Cal-Am shall provide customer notice and explanation of the rate changes, with the notice first reviewed by the Commission’s Public Advisor.”

Request:

This advice letter filing is being made to request recovery of the WRAM/MCBA balance through 2014 for the Monterey County District of \$31.7 million. Decision 16-12-003 authorizes the recovery of \$39.8 million reduced by the collections from the existing surcharges, which is \$8.1 million.

The implementation of the WRAM/MCBA meter surcharge for the Monterey District will replace the current volumetric WRAM/MCA surcharges.

Tier Designation:

Pursuant to D.16-12-003, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 2 designation.

Effective Date:

California American requests an effective date of January 29,2017.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST²

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this AL. When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds³ are:

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

DWA must receive a response or protest via email (**or** postal mail) within 20 days of the date the AL is filed. When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

REPLIES⁴

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.
