Background:

California American Water submits this request to recover cost related to the Chualar Fire Flow Improvement Project pursuant to advice letter filing consistent with the approved settlement agreement. Chualar Fire Flow Improvement Project will provide needed fire flow storage and pumping for meeting the fire flow storage requirement, which includes equalization storage needs. This project was approved by the Public Utilities Commission under 2015 General Rate Case under a partial settlement agreement (A.13-07-002) to allow California American Water to plan, design and install fire protection improvements serving the town of Chualar. The project was approved for \$925,000.

PURPOSE

This advice letter filing is being made in order to request the recovery of costs associated with the Chualar Tank (Fire Flow Improvement) Project for Monterey Main, Ryan Ranch, Hidden Hills, Bishop, and Ambler Park service areas of Monterey County District.

BACKGROUND

The project is an advice letter project authorized in the partial settlement agreement¹ approved in D.15-04-007.

DISCUSSION

The project allowed California American Water to upgrade the only water storage facility serving the town of Chualar, thereby allowing the water system to meet current fire protection standards. The inclusion of the Chualar Fire Flow Improvement in rate base will increase plant in service by \$932,856, which includes \$909,000 in actual project costs, plus \$43,440 in accrued interest, and less (\$19,584) in accumulated depreciation.

REQUEST

California American Water requests authorization to increase the revenue requirement for Monterey County District by \$144,803 or 0.27% for a total authorized operating revenue of \$54,174,794. Rates will increase for the Monterey County District.

TIER DESIGNATION

Pursuant to D.15-04-007, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 2 designation.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST²

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this AL. When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds³ are:

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.
7. A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.
