Your Rates Are Changing Monterey District: Non-Residential

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) recently ordered changes to how California American Water bills for water service on the Monterey Peninsula. While most of the changes apply to residential customers, there will also be rate differences for commercial, public authority and industrial – or non-residential – customers.

There will be no change to the current division system. However, the CPUC has re-allocated the recovery of approximately \$3 million in annual water system costs from residential customers to nonresidential customers and approved a five-year WRAM surcharge to recover revenue that was previously approved but uncollected due to increased conservation.


