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## Purpose:

This supplemental advice letter is being filed to reflect the 2019 escalation year rates and rate design incorporated into AL 1234-A, resulting from D.18-12-021.

This supplemental advice letter filing requests the recovery of costs associated with Hexavalent Chromium treatment projects in the Sacramento (Project I15-600081) and Dunnigan (Project I15-630001) service areas. Specifically, California American Water (Cal-Am) seeks recovery of \$10,522,761 of capital and \$8,880 of annual incremental operating expenses. Cal-Am seeks recovery of the \$858,329 of incremental revenue requirement and expenses tracked in the Chromium 6 Memorandum Accounts through August 31, 2018, and recovery of \$1,355,287 in revenue related to total project costs in rates going forward effective October 1, 2019. Additionally, Cal-Am requests that the Chrome-6 memo account remain open to track incremental revenue requirement and expenses incurred for the period between September 1, 2018 and the effective date of this advice letter.

#### Background:

On September 19, 2018, CAW filed Advice Letter 1214 requesting recovery of project costs for the Sacramento and Dunnigan Hexavalent Chromium Treatment projects tracked in the Los Angeles County and Sacramento Districts Chromium-6 Memorandum Account (memo account). As described in the memo account, and as further detailed in AL 1214, Cal-Am is requesting a) inclusion of the revenue requirements for the authorized projects in rates going forward, and b) a surcharge to recover the incremental revenue requirement and expenses tracked in the memo accounts. Additionally, Cal-Am requests that the Chrome-6 memo account remain open to track incremental revenue requirement and expenses incurred for the period between September 1, 2018 and the effective date of this advice letter. This Advice Letter is designated as Tier 3 in compliance with the regulatory procedures outlined within the memo account.

Subsequent to the AL 1214 filing CAW responded to discovery requests from Cal PA regarding the project costs and the proposed recovery. After responding to discovery requests CAW and Cal PA met to discuss the project costs and project workpapers. Based on these discussions and on the information provided CAW and Cal PA agreed to the adjustments outlined below and CAW filed AL 1214-A on March 8, 2019 to address these points

- Revise the Asset Cost Summary table provided in AL 1214 Appendix A to match the AL 1214 workpapers. The updated Asset Cost Summary is included as Attachment A to this Advice Letter. This revision has no rate impact.
- Correct for discrepancies between depreciation base as presented in different sections
  of the workpapers. Depreciation bases included for revenue requirement calculations are
  based on total project costs less the adjustments incorporated via this supplemental
  advice letter filing.
- In an effort to resolve disputed issues between the parties with Advice Letter 1214
  parties agree to temporary removal of overhead amounts accrued to the Chromium-6
  projects in the Test Year 2018 in the amount of \$78,385 (\$37,579 related to the
  Dunnigan Cr6 project and \$40,806 related to the Sacramento Cr6 project). Parties agree
  that this adjustment is made for temporary ratemaking purposes and overhead will be
  trued up in future filings.
- Remove \$12,776 in legal expenses from the Sacramento Chromium-6 project.
- Remove \$33,921 in contractor costs from the Dunnigan Cr6 due to lack of original contractor invoice.

- Update workpapers to reflect authorized ad valorem rate (1.1794%) and franchise fee (0.2300%) factors at time of advice letter filing.
- Adjust project costs to reflect invoice amounts. This adjustment affects various transactions and results in a net project decrease of \$183.

Finally, in AL 1214-A CAW noted that it anticipated it would file an additional supplement which reflected the 2019 escalation year rates coming out of D.18-12-021. With the approval of AL 1234-A, CAW is submitting this supplement to AL 1214 to reflect the rates and rate design incorporated in the 2019 escalation year filing.

# **Revised Request:**

Based on the adjustments discussed above, and in compliance with the Regulatory Procedures outlined in the memorandum account description, and assuming the requested effective date of October 1, 2019, Cal-Am hereby requests authorization for recovery as follows:

- a) Inclusion of the revenue requirements for the authorized projects in rates going forward. Cal-Am here by requests authorization to increase the rates in the Sacramento and Dunnigan service areas to reflect a revenue requirement increase of \$1,355,287 or 2.48% of revenue requirement authorized in 1234-A, CAW's 2019 escalation year filing. D.15-11-012 approved consolidation of the Dunnigan service area with the Sacramento service area for ratemaking treatment. D.18-12-021 approved consolidation of Dunnigan rates with Sacramento rates, and this consolidation was implemented through AL 1230-B, CAW's 2018 test year filing. Thus, in order to spread the costs of the Dunnigan related projects Cal-Am has spread requested costs based on service connections in the Sacramento and Dunnigan service areas.
- b) A surcharge to recover the incremental revenue requirement and expenses tracked in the memo accounts. Cal-Am here by requests authorization to recover the \$858,329 of incremental revenue requirement and expenses tracked in the memorandum account through August 31, 2018 via a surcharge of \$.0097 per 100 gallons for customers in the Sacramento County District.

Cal-Am further requests the Chrome-6 memo account remain open to track incremental revenue requirement and operating expenses incurred, between Sept 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 through the effective date of the advice letter for reviewing in the subsequent GRC filing.

Revised tariffs submitted with this filing are based on revenue requirement and rate design in CAW's 2019 escalation year filing, AL 1234-A coming out of D.18-12-021.

Pursuant to the Regulatory Procedure provided in the approved memorandum account, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 3 designation.

- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.
- 7. A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

# **SACRAMENTO TARIFF AREA**

 A surcharge is included in each bill to recover the net under-collection in the Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism (WRAM) and Modified Cost Balancing Account (MCBA). Per D.18-12-021, the cap on WRAM/MCBA surcharges was raised to 15% of the authorized revenue requirement. For the period ending December 31, 2017, the net under-collection totals \$18,955,673 including interest. The surcharge is \$0.0617 per 100 gallons and will remain effective for 36 months beginning March 31, 2018.
